

Batch Image Resizing

Photographers, publishers or just regular users often need to send images over the Internet. Images produced by digital cameras and scanners often have large sizes. Digital photo images may have sizes of 1, 2, 5 megabytes or more. These images take long time to send and receive, especially when using dial-up connections.

Another problem is publishing images on a website. An optimal size of a web-friendly picture is about 20-50 Kbytes. Before publishing each large image must be resized. When dealing with a few images, each image can be resized individually in photoshop or any other image editing software.

In cases when the number of images is high, for example 20, 50, or even 1000, image resizing by hand can be a very time consuming and error prone procedure.

Batch image resizing software offer efficient solutions for resizing batches of image files for:

- Sending images as email attachments
- Publishing image galleries on web sites
- Using online photo-printing services
- Uploading images to photo-sharing web sites
- Any other websites where images can be used such as eBay and other auction sites
- Creating slide shows online or offline
- Product presentations, sales presentations, creating product catalogs, etc…
